Here is the official response in coordination with Alberta Health and Hockey Alberta.

Okotoks Minor Hockey Association's foremost priority is the health and safety of our participants, volunteers and hockey families. We have been proactively working alongside Hockey Alberta and following Health Canada, Hockey Canada and local public health officials in regards to the Coronavirus (COVID-19). In light of recent events, the OMHA & OOAA Executive has been instructed to immediately suspend all hockey activities.

Team gatherings
Dryland training

All ice will be officially cancelled tomorrow morning per the immediate request from Alberta Health Service.

We will be proactive in informing our constituents on all upcoming protocols and required actions as they become available.

We recognize the tremendous effort that has been put forth to start the season by individuals in our community as they participate in Canada's game. This is without question another tough message to send out to our OMHA and OOAA teams and families and it is difficult to process the hockey season abruptly being put on hold. Alberta Health Services feel this is the best course of action in order to do our part in keeping our community safe from further spreading COVID_19.

The OMHA and OOAA appreciates the magnitude of this situation and sincerely thanks the many stakeholders for their support as we all work through the logistics of this two week lockdown. We encourage everyone to keep themselves informed of information available through the various health departments as the medical community works diligently to manage the Coronavirus. We thank you for your attention to this bulletin and sincerely wish you well.

We understand the excitement for hockey to return in Okotoks over the past month and we will be ready to drop the puck again in two weeks.
